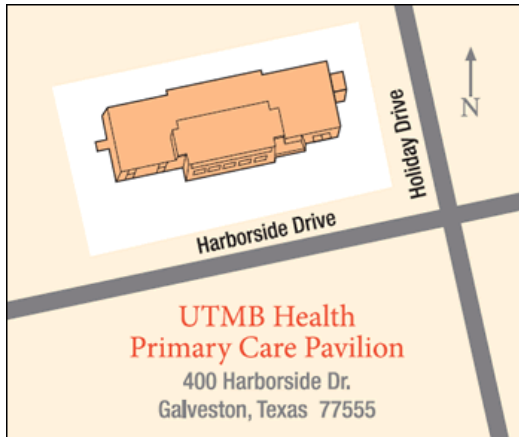


## General Information

## Student Health Services

The Office of Counseling and Career Services serves as the liaison between Texas A&M University: Galveston Campus and the University of Texas Medical Branch for Student Health Services.

### Services:

#### Available by Appointment Only

Student Health Fees provide coverage for the office visit. Students will not be billed for the clinic visit. Students who have health insurance with a deductible may have the clinic visit billed toward the deductible.



### Services **not included** in Health Fee:

Students are responsible for payment at billed amount:

- Ancillary services, such as laboratory & radiology studies.
- Any chargeable supplies or durable medical equipment
- Any medication given that generates a UTMB pharmacy charge
- Referrals to specialists, or for physical therapy
- **EMERGENCY ROOM & HOSPITAL IN-PATIENT CARE COSTS**
- Routine medication refills without an exam

### Periods of coverage for student health services:

Coverage begins the week classes starting, during normal enrollment periods. Students must be enrolled half time or more in order for coverage to be provided for that semester. Services will not be included during breaks in between semesters (unless student is enrolled in intercession classes).

### Immunizations (Recommended):

All students at Texas A&M University: Galveston Campus are recommended to have the following immunizations:

- Tetanus Diphtheria (within the past 10 years)
- Measles (2 doses)
- Mumps
- Rubella
- Polio (under 18 years old)
- TB skin Test
- Hepatitis B Vaccine
- Menomune (Meningitis vaccine)
- Flue Vaccine
